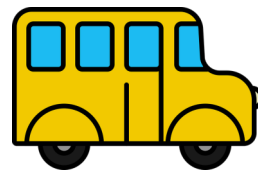

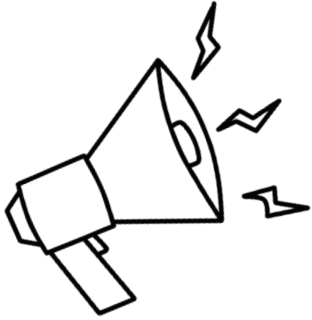

Dyslexia-Friendly and Multilingual Resources Available Through Public Libraries

The Provincial Library and Literacy Office has launched a pilot project to support public libraries in Saskatchewan in providing dyslexia-friendly print resources to children. The Regina, Moose Jaw and Saskatoon public libraries, and the Parkland, Chinook, Wheatland and Wapiti regional library systems are participating. The books can be accessed through Saskatchewan's integrated library system and found in the [online catalogue](#) by doing a "dyslexia-friendly" keyword search.

Additionally, the PLLO houses and distributes multilingual print and e-books in over 20 languages to public libraries and their patrons. Teachers are encouraged to contact their local public library for assistance in bringing in books for specific languages and in accessing the e-book platform.
