
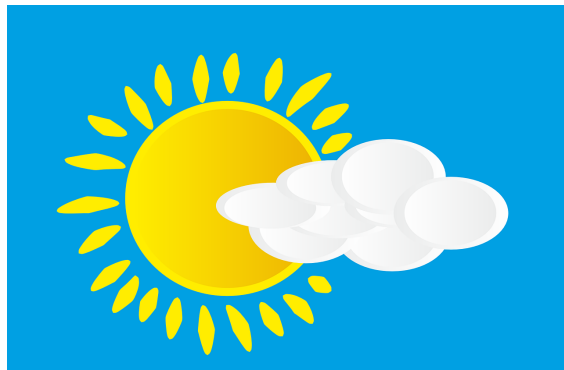
**SUMMER CAMPS ARE BACK AT SASKATCHEWAN POLYTECHNIC**
