Dear Parent/Guardians,

Halloween is just around the corner and we know many of you are getting costumes ready for your children. We thought that it would be a good idea to give you an idea of our plans for the day.

Halloween is one of our school Spirit Days, therefore, students will have the option to wear a Halloween costume or dress in orange and black. Each classroom will have different plans for the morning but in the afternoon, there will be a dance for Kindergarten to 4 and another for the grades 5 to 8.

If your child decides to wear a Halloween costume, please remember that it will be a regular school day. Students will be doing the normal school activities like learning in their classrooms, going to the gym and having outdoor recess.

Please consider the following when deciding if your child will wear a costume to school:

- Your child must be able to take off and put on the costume without adult assistance. They will need bathroom breaks during the day.
- They must be able to put on a warm jacket over the costume for outdoor recess.
- Your child must be able to sit in a chair while wearing the costume.
- Your child must be able to participate in physical education classes and the school dance while wearing the costume.

The costume must be appropriate for a school. No gore, no knives, no guns or violent props.

Please remember the focus with our Halloween activities is to have fun. We ask that everyone exercise good judgement with their costume choices and remember that St. Lorenzo is a Catholic elementary school where we have students as young as 5 years old.
