

Dear BJM Parents / Guardians,

BJM school fees are coming soon! Some of you may have already paid some team fees; thank you! As you may already know, [My School Bucks](#) is a website that we use to communicate fee amounts, as well as provide an easy-to-use on-line payment option.

If paying on-line is not for you, stop by BJM's Main Office where we accept cash, debit/credit, and cheques (made out to 'BJM High School'; **cheques are only accepted until May 1<sup>st</sup>**). [Click here for BJM Office Hours](#).

Even if you plan on paying in person, [My School Bucks](#) is a great way to check on the status of your fees. Please go to the site and ensure that you have an account set-up, with your student(s) attached to your profile.

A few things to note:

- There are still quite a few overdue fees, please go to [My School Bucks](#) and check your account.
- If there is a fee for a class that is no longer on your child's schedule, it will be removed soon.
- **Fees are due March 13, 2026.** (To ensure you receive a copy of the 2025/2026 BJM Yearbook, please pay your fees on time!)
- **ALL school fees must be paid before participating in BJM Graduation 2026.**

This cost will be added to student fee invoices.</p> <p>This cost-recovery fee helps cover the expense of supervision that is not funded by provincial operating grants.</p> <p>The level of supervision needed for high school students (compared to elementary students) is different, but they still require monitoring and supervision. The modest fee reflects that and the fact that some students only occasionally spend lunch at school.</p>	\$25.00
