Summer Opportunity for Grade 10, 11, and 12 students: Youth Police Academy-The goal of the Youth Police Academy (YPA) is to give students a better understanding of the Saskatoon Police Service through information and education. During the 4-week course, participants will hear from SPS members from a variety of different units. These members will provide an in-depth look into a specific unit and discuss their roles and responsibilities of the job. Not only will participants hear first-hand from these front-line workers but they will also have the opportunity to observe real Police exhibits, try on equipment and experience what it is like to be an officer...for a few hours. The 4-week course runs in July, with classes held on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday's from 2:30 p.m. – 4:00 p.m. The course begins on July 4th and ends on July 27th. The sessions are held in the Community Room in the Saskatoon Police Service Headquarters; 76 - 25th Street East, Saskatoon. Applicants must be Grade 10 – 12 students enrolled in high school. A local record check will be performed by SPS staff prior to approval. Candidates are expected to commit to making all of the sessions.
