# Eligibility for Graduation

To be eligible for Graduation, a student must:

- Have at least 19 credits before entering 2nd Semester.
- Including 5 level 30 credits
- Be registered in enough courses that will total at least 24 credits by the end of June.
- Have passed or be passing all **required** courses at midterm of Sem 2. Students who are not in this position will meet with administration
- Attend the Grade 12 Retreat – June 3<sup>rd</sup>
- Complete the application to Graduate Form – TODAY
- Pay all school fees.

# Honour Roll

- Based on the Sem 1 marks and Sem 2 midterm marks.
- If you are taking a cyber school class, you **must be completed ½ the course (midterm)** for it to be used in the calculation. If you are not, it will not be used for honour roll and may not be eligible. **MONDAY APRIL 22<sup>nd</sup>**
- **Required Honour Roll Courses**
  - ✓ ELA30
  - ✓ ELB30
  - ✓ CST30
  - ✓ HIS30 or IST30
  - ✓ 4 next highest Level 30 classes

# Honour Roll French Immersion

- **Required Honour Roll Courses**
  - ✓ **ECA30F**
  - ✓ **ELA30 or ELB30**
  - ✓ **FIM30F**
  - ✓ **SSI30F**
  - ✓ **4 next highest Level 30 classes**

- All Grade 12 students are required to attend the retreat.

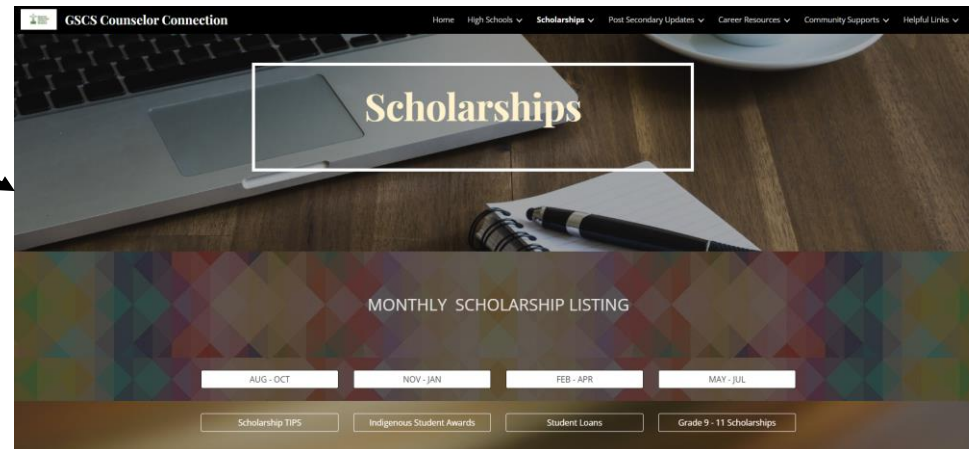
