1 Start with staff member involved.

A conversation is often all that is needed to understand different perspectives and come to an agreement.

2 Contact a school administrator.

The principal or vice-principal may want to meet as a group or talk to parties individually so different perspectives are heard, understood and considered.

3 Contact the school's superintendent.

He or she will continue to work towards a resolution.

4 Contact the director of education.

He can help determine a course of action.

5 Connect with your school trustees.

Each school has designated trustee liaisons who can work with you and the director of education to reach a solution.
