Education Property Tax Declaration - To ensure the education portion of your municipal property taxes are supporting your Catholic school, please make sure your school support is shown as "Separate" on your annual property tax notice. If you are Catholic and your school support is not shown as "Separate", please fill out a tax declaration form and submit it to the office of your municipality. Also, if you have recently moved, you will need to complete a declaration form for your new residence; declarations from previous properties do not carry over. You must reside within the boundaries of the school division in order to designate taxes to Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools. 
