Family/Public Skate times at the rink are Mondays and Wednesdays, 4pm-6pm and Saturdays 10am-12pm.

A friendly reminder of some rink rules:

- Have fun and be respectful. ❤️
- No sticks during family/public skating times or learn to skate programs. Respect the rink skating schedule as posted. 🛼
- Spend a few minutes scraping the ice. 🛠️
- Shovel snow OVER the boards. When shovelled snow is left against the boards, it turns to solid ice and the volunteer crew is getting too old to shovel hard now. 🌨️
- Always leave the place cleaner than you found it. Don't leave garbage and if you see some, please pick it up. There are garbage cans outside and inside the warm-up rink. 🗑️
- Children and inexperienced skaters should use an approved helmet while on the ice to prevent injuries. 🧢🧢🧢
- Do not use the rink during unusually warm weather. ☀️
- Stay off the ice surface while it's being resurfaced. 🧊

Parents, please share these rules with your kids if they frequent the ice. Our volunteers spend countless hours away from their own families over the winter season to maintain this rink for our neighbourhood. Respect is requested. Thank you!
