STUDENT PARENTAL WAIVER

First Student makes a concerted effort to select bus stop locations that are as safe as possible for each student. On routes that have group stops, stops are located where possible at street corners. We do not take buses into crescents cul-de-sac's or private driveways. When Children from Pre-K to Grade 2 are brought home from school, it is important to have an adult or guardian at the bus stop. Your bus driver will watch over your child as they leave the bus each day. If a parent or guardian is not present to receive the child, the driver will not leave the student unattended unless a *Student Parental Waiver* has been completed and is file with First Student. If First Student does not have a Waiver and a parent or guardian is not present, the driver will return the student to the school where the parent or guardian will be called to come pick them up. If you feel that your Pre-K to Grade 2 student can get off without having a parent or guardian present, please complete this form. If First Student does not have a completed waiver in their possession, your student will not be dropped off unattended. Thank you for assisting us in our goal to keep the safety of the students as our number one priority.

BUS RULES

1. **Follow all drivers' instructions promptly.**
2. Students must be ready outside to board the bus **FIVE MINUTES before their scheduled departure time.** The bus driver will not leave a departure point before the arranged scheduled time; however, they cannot wait for children that are not ready to leave on schedule.
3. Students **must** go straight to the bus at the end of the school day, to avoid anyone being left behind. If a child is left behind, the child must go to the front office where a staff member will call the parents/caregivers to pick up the child.
4. Pre-K, Kindergarten and Special Needs children **MUST be physically seen and acknowledged by guardian,** or the driver will **NOT** allow the child to exit the bus and the child will be returned to the school. If a child has to returned to the school due to nobody home to meet the child bussing privileges may be suspended. First Student will contact family to discuss suspension of bussing privileges.
5. Seating will be assigned by the bus driver. Students must stay seated until your stop. For safety, arms and legs must be kept within the seat area.
6. If your child has to cross the street at drop off, they must wait on the curb twelve feet back from the bus until the bus has cleared the drop off area, so that any vehicle has a clear line of visibility before they cross.
7. Be polite and quiet. Respect your driver and fellow students. Foul language, shouting and fooling around are **not** permitted.
8. At railway crossings, be quiet.
9. Carry-on items such as lunch boxes or books must be held on the lap or kept on the floor by your feet. Some items present a safety concern and will not be allowed on the school bus.
10. Aisles must be kept clear of all obstructions.
11. Windows are to be adjusted only with the permission of the driver. Do not throw anything out of the bus.
12. Eating and drinking is **NEVER** permitted on the bus this is a possible choking hazard.
13. **Please** wake any sleeping children you see, and tell the driver.
14. **Tell the driver** if you are being bothered by other students.
15. All First Student buses are **scent free** zones please remember no fragrances as many have allergies.

If there are delays or cancellations with your child's bus route, there are a couple of options available to you to find out information quickly:

Students who do not follow the drivers' instructions may be suspended from the bus. It is the job of parents and caregivers to review the bus rules with their children so everyone understands that breaking these rules may lead to a suspension on the bus.
