Welcome back - Semester 2 has begun!

**February is Black History month and Indigenous Storytelling month** so we will also be providing opportunities for our students to be engaged in these events and activities.



**Early Dismissal** - Please note that on **Thursday, February 5th** students will be dismissed at 12:30 and we will be hosting out Grade 8 feeder school that afternoon. As a result, the main entrance/exit will be closed to our Holy Cross students at 12:30 as buses will be dropping off the Grade 8 students at that time. Please plan to use a different exit that day. Students must also leave the school at 12:30 as the school is closed for the afternoon (unless you are a student leader helping with Grade 8 visits). Thank you for your help and cooperation! We will have staff at the main doors/area to block it off and re-direct traffic.
