Education Property Tax Declaration

To ensure the education portion of your municipal property taxes are supporting your Catholic school, please make sure your school support is shown as "Separate" on your annual property tax notice. If you are Catholic and your school support is not shown as "Separate", please fill out a tax declaration form and submit it to the office of your municipality. Also, if you have recently moved, you will need to complete a declaration form for your new residence; declarations from previous properties do not carry over. You must reside within the boundaries of the school division in order to designate taxes to Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools. Now is the time to register for Kindergarten for the fall! At Father Robinson School, we are committed to helping students reach their full potential in a faith-filled learning environment while encouraging them to make a positive difference in the world. Children who will be **five years old by December 31, 2026**, are eligible to begin Kindergarten in **September 2026**.

Registration forms are on our website. Please download the registration form, complete it, save it, and then email it to Father.Robinson@gscs.ca **Birth Certificate and Baptism certificate (if applicable) are required for proof of age.**

Noon Lunch supervision fees are overdue – Thank you to everyone who has made payment. If you have not, please make your payments today. The fee will be \$10 per month per student. Half-time kindergarten students will pay \$5 per month. Fees will be capped at \$20 per month per family. Water skiing has been adapted so that physically disabled athletes can participate and compete in slalom, tricks and jumping events. A headset system is used with vision impaired individuals. Paraplegics and quadriplegics, leg amputees (above and below knee) use a sit ski, which is wider than a normal ski and has a cage similar to downhill skiing. Arm amputees and athletes with grip strength impairment will use different slings and harnesses to assist with riding.
