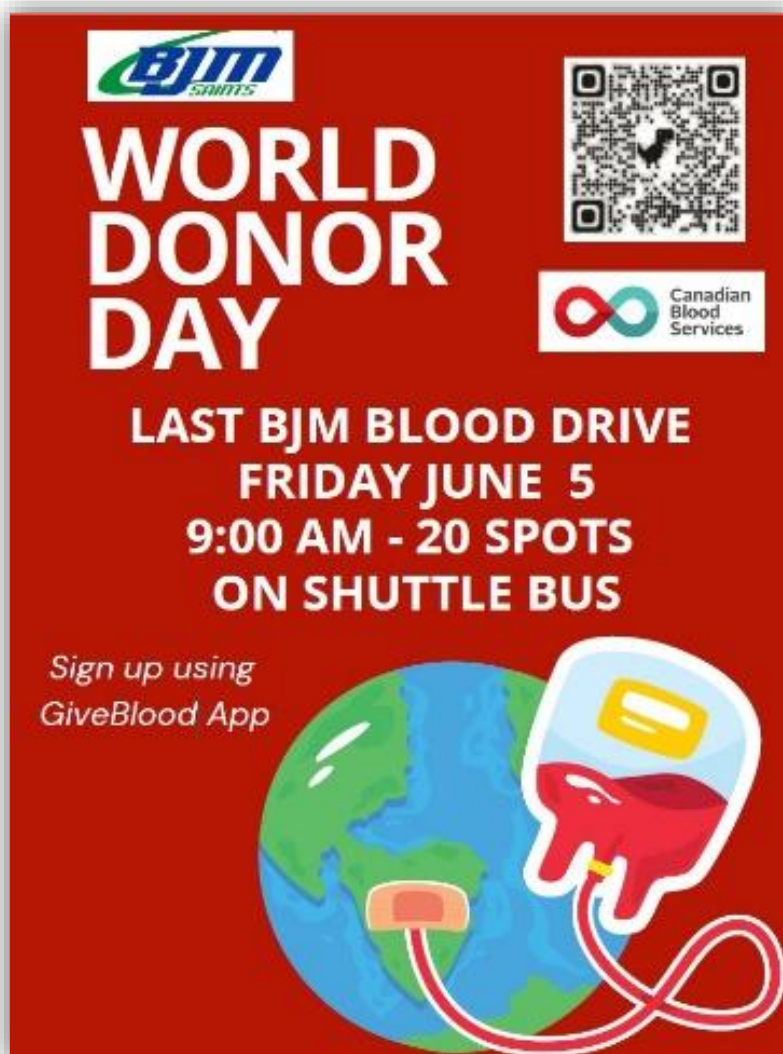

**Grade 12 Students: Great Plains College is excited to share that a new full-time Primary Care Paramedic (PCP) program will be launching at our Warman Campus beginning in December 2026!** The one-year certificate program combines classroom learning, hands-on training, and hospital and ambulance practicums in the Saskatoon region to prepare students for careers in emergency medical services. Graduates will be eligible to write the provincial licensing exam for registration with the Saskatchewan College of Paramedics. Applications are now open, and students who apply by October 31, 2026, will automatically be considered for Entrance Scholarships ranging from \$500-\$3,000. **University of Saskatchewan - Arts and Science Students:** I'm reaching out to share a new resource the College of Arts and Science at USask just launched for incoming students: **ArtSci Ready**. This resource centralizes key information to support new students as they transition into Arts and Science, including program requirements, course registration guidance, how to navigate PAWS, and an overview of student services and supports.

Students can access ArtSci Ready through the [New to Arts and Science webpage](https://artsandscience.usask.ca/students/new-students.php) ( <https://artsandscience.usask.ca/students/new-students.php> ) and engage with the content in a format that works best for them: either through the PDF guide, online Canvas space, or live facilitated sessions. ArtSci Ready is intended to be an evergreen resource going forward, available to students in future terms as soon as they accept their offer.

In addition to course selection and registration guidance, the Canvas space also addresses common student questions and "how-to"s such as buying textbooks, getting a parking pass, and AP/IB transfer credits, etc.

Going forward, the advising process for incoming students will be standardized as follows:

1. Students review *ArtSci Ready* through their preferred format (PDF, Canvas, or facilitated session)
2. Students complete the course planning worksheet to the best of their ability (available through the PDF, Canvas or the ArtSci Ready webpage)
3. Students book an advising appointment if additional support is needed

Students admitted for Spring, Summer and Fall 2026, as well as Winter 2027, were emailed about *ArtSci Ready* on May 1 and invited to join the Canvas space. They can access all formats through the [New to Arts and Science](#) webpage if they are unsure how to log in.
