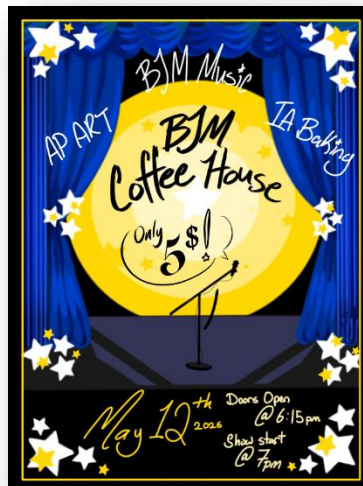

GSCS Virtual Summer School offers a full range of courses from Thursday, July 2nd to 11:00 PM on Friday, August 21st, 2026. These courses are virtual and done completely online. This creates a very flexible situation which allows students access to their courses 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. **PLEASE NOTE:** To strengthen academic integrity, students may be randomly selected for proctoring in our summer school courses.
