<u>Firefighter Introduction Recruitment Experience (F.I.R.E.) Cadet Program:</u> For Grade 11 and Grade 12 students. The F.I.R.E. Cadets program gives high school students the opportunity to learn about what it takes to be a firefighter through building new and strengthening existing life skills. These skills are intended to contribute to one's success in all aspects of life, including future career applications. Participants are coached in responsibility, respect, leadership, community involvement, teamwork, pride, and professionalism.
