



Cadets program gives high school students the opportunity to learn about what it takes to be a firefighter through building new and strengthening existing life skills. - Students may choose to earn a credit as well, Career & Work Exploration A30 (CWA30). If this option is chosen, there would be academic work to do along with the practical experience.
