Grade 12 Students - Schulich Leader Scholarship: These are some of Canada's most coveted undergraduate STEM scholarships. They are awarded to entrepreneurial-minded high school graduates enrolling in a Science, Technology, Engineering or Math program at 20 partner universities across Canada; \$120,000 scholarships are designated for students pursuing an engineering degree, and \$100,000 scholarships are designated for students pursuing a science, technology or math degree.
