

To Bishop Roborecki Families,

This year Bishop Roborecki School will be having a Family Advent Liturgy at St. Patrick's Parish on Tuesday, December 13 from 6:30 pm to 8:00 pm. The Grade 2/3 class will lead the Third Advent liturgy, and the choir will be singing. Following the liturgy, students in Kindergarten to Grade 5 will be singing:



Kindergarten, Grade 1, Grade 2, Grade 2/3 - "Oh, What a Special Night"
Grade 2/3, Grade 3/4, Grade 4, Grade 5 - "It's Christmas"
Kindergarten to Grade 5 - "We Wish You a Merry Christmas"

When you arrive at the church, students in the Grade 2/3 class will sit in the reserved pews at the front of the church, and choir members are to gather at the front. All other students will sit with their family for the liturgy and will be called up to the front at their respective time.

Students in Kindergarten, Grade 1, and Grade 2 should arrive 10 minutes early to pick up their animal headband from their teachers.

Families who do not have children directly involved in the Family Advent Liturgy, are more than welcome to attend. If you have any questions regarding the evening, please ask your child's teacher.
