Thank you to everyone who joined us for this month's CSCC meeting! Here are the key updates and highlights:


 **Website & Grad photos**– The St. Luke website continues to be updated and now includes CSCC meeting minutes from the last few meetings. CSCC approved to help with the cost of purchasing Grade 8 grad photos.

 **School Policies & Safety**- The school's scent policy was discussed, with a focus on handling allergy-related issues. Concerns about the water fountain's quality led to a water test, which came back showing the water is safe.

 **Easter Basket Raffle** – Ticket sales are ongoing during the lunch hour with the draw taking place on **Thursday, April 17**. Half of the proceeds will be donated to two local charities.





 **Artist in Residence**- An artist-in-residence grant proposal was presented, and the council discussed its potential implementation.

 **Fundraiser** – Future fundraising ideas, such as a family photo fundraiser or a fall market, were discussed.
