CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF CHILDREN

For the past few years we have had inquiries from parents of a number of children who were not baptized as infants and now their child is showing a keen interest in receiving the sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and First Communion).

To try to meet this need we, at Holy Spirit Parish, have created a process for school-aged children who would like to receive the sacraments. As the children and their

parent(s) come together they experience sessions that are not only teaching the children about being a Catholic Christian but they are also life-giving both for the children and their parents. The children learn much while they are having fun. We will begin sessions mid-October meeting about every two weeks right after school for one hour. – probably Tuesday or Wednesday. These children will receive Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist at the Easter Vigil which this year will be April 8.
