Scholarships and Awards

Canadian Tire Award: The recipient of this award must have high academic achievement, along with participation in school activities, and be continuing on to post-secondary.

Community of Saints Award: The Hastings Family commissioned the Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools Foundation to establish this award to recognize a Grade 12 student from Bishop James Mahoney High School. The student must have exemplified a spirit of acceptance, assistance, consideration, and comradeship towards fellow students and especially students with special needs.

Grade 12 Guy Giroux Award: Guy Giroux was a much-loved teacher at BJM who passed away unexpectedly in 2001. Among his many attributes, Mr. Giroux always had a soft spot in his heart for students with tenacity and strength of character to meet challenges and wished to recognize their success in the classroom and school environment. Recipients are students who have taken the personal initiative to significantly improve as a student throughout the year or high school career at BJM. Improvement must be in evidence in attendance, attitude, work habits, grades, and facing personal challenges.

Grade 12 Leadership Award: Leadership Awards are given to Grade 12 students in recognition of their overall contribution in all areas of school life. Recipients are chosen based on qualities that include commitment to Christian life, high academic achievement, and participation in both social and athletic activities at Bishop James Mahoney.

HeART Award: This award is in memory of Kathryn Stan-Ross. The recipient of this award demonstrates a passion for visual art, photography, and/or graphic design. They consistently contribute their time and abilities to the school by participating in a wide variety of art-related activities. They must have completed two or more Grade 12 art-related classes in their Grade 12 year at BJM.

Kiwanis Club of Riversdale Scholarship: The Kiwanis Club of Riversdale Scholarship is presented to a graduate who is pursuing post-secondary studies. Candidates should have acceptable marks, be of good character, have participated in student activities, and have shown some involvement in the community.

Les and Irene Dubé Service & Justice Scholarship: The Les and Irene Dubé Service & Justice Scholarship, from St. Thomas More College, is designed to recognize a student's demonstrated passion for social justice. The recipient, who is successful academically and shows sensitivity to the marginalized, will participate in social justice programming at St. Thomas More College next academic year.

St. Anne's Catholic Women's League Bursary: St. Anne's CWL presents bursaries to graduating students continuing on to post-secondary who best exemplify a Catholic Christian lifestyle and are involved in the School, Parish and Community.

St. Anne's Knights of Columbus Bursary: St Anne's Knights of Columbus presents bursaries to graduating students continuing on to post-secondary who best exemplify the Christian values of compassion, generosity and a Catholic Christian lifestyle.

SYA Scholarship: The Saskatchewan Apprenticeship and Trade Certification Commission (SATCC), with its partners in industry and government, administer a Youth Apprenticeship Industry Scholarship Program to reward students' commitment and achievement in the Saskatchewan Youth Apprenticeship (SYA) Program. Students are encouraged to graduate high school with knowledge in the trades and to pursue apprenticeship or other post-secondary training in a designated apprenticeship trade after graduation.

University of Toronto National Book Award: Recipients demonstrate superior academic performance, original and creative thought, and exceptional achievement in a broad context. They demonstrate enthusiasm for intellectual exploration and have a strong involvement in the lives of their schools and communities.

Athletic and Social Awards presented on June 11, 2025

Bishop James Mahoney Athletic Service Award: awarded yearly to a Grade 12 student who assists the athletic program as a support staff member. While these contributions often go unnoticed, our athletic programs would not prosper without the work that these support staff provide.

To help you along the way, Saskatchewan offers programs like the Saskatchewan Advantage Scholarship, which provides \$750 per year to a lifetime maximum of \$3,000 for eligible students attending a Saskatchewan post-secondary institution. Additionally, through the Graduate Retention Program, you may qualify for up to \$24,000 in tax rebates on tuition paid to a post-secondary institution if you choose to live and work in Saskatchewan after graduation. I encourage you to visit www.saskatchewan.ca to explore these and other opportunities available to you in our province.
