

# **Required / Elective Courses**

- Required courses are mandated by the Ministry of Education - all students must take them. It is your responsibility to ensure that you have these. If you have been unsuccessful OR not taken a required course, you must sign up for this next year
- Elective courses are not required and are selected by each individual student based on what is offered
- Both Required and Elective courses count towards your 24 credits needed to graduate
- LAS/EAL Tutorial classes do not count towards your 24 credits

#### <u>NOTE:</u>

#### GRADE 10 COURSES are labelled as '10'.

i.e. One of the Grade 10 English courses is ELA10.

#### GRADE 11 COURSES are labelled as '20'.

i.e. One of the Grade 11 Math courses is MWA20.

#### GRADE 12 COURSES are labelled as '30'.

i.e. The Grade 12 History course is HIS30.

#### **ANY COURSE ENDING IN A '1' is a MODIFIED course.** i.e. MATH 11, ESC21, ELA21



# **Stretched Math Classes**


Allows for <u>more time</u> to cover the course content. \*Stretch Math is designed for a student who find the subject difficult, but works hard and completes homework\*
