

# 2024 – 2025 Principal's Honour Roll

## Changes to the Average Requirements

\*\*This is to advise all students and parents that the St. Joseph High School Principal's Honour Roll requirements for the 2024-2025 school year will have the following changes:

- **Current Grades 9 to 11;** In fall of 2025, averages will be calculated in determining the Principal's Honour Roll. The aggregate mark for each of these grade levels will now be at **85% or higher** for the "Principal's Honour Roll." The students with an average of **90% or higher** will remain as the designation of "Principal's Honour Roll With Distinction."

- **Current Grade 12's (Graduating class of 2025);** The aggregate mark will remain, at **80% or higher** for the "Principal's Honour Roll". The students with an average of **90% or higher** will remain as the designation of "Principal's Honour Roll With Distinction."

**Honour Roll averages are calculated up to two decimal places (averages are not rounded up).**

**PLEASE NOTE for the 2025/2026 school year, the aggregate mark for all grade levels will need to be at 85% or higher for the Principal's Honour Roll and the average mark of 90% or higher for "Principal's Honour Roll With Distinction."**
