Attendance and average must be 80%+, accepted into a post-secondary program as a full-time student. Demonstrated exceptional ability in drafting, art, graphic art/design or performing arts/music.

Cathedral of the Holy Family Award

This award is given to a graduating grade 12 student who reflects the goal of chaplaincy to nurture and foster Christian leadership and service. This student would be an involved and active member in faith life of their parish and school faith ministry (lector, acolyte, music, eucharistic minister, usher, etc.). The student would be actively involved in extra-curricular activities either in athletics or fine arts or both. The student is a witness to the faith in Jesus Christ according to the mind of the Catholic Church.

Parent Guardian Group Christian Service Award

Graduate must exemplify Christian values and principles. Demonstrates qualities of stewardship and service both in and out of school and quietly serves our Lord in his/her encounters with others. Student should work through quiet ways, prayer life and volunteerism.

Les and Irene Dubé Service & Justice Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to students from each Saskatchewan Catholic High School. It is designed to recognize a student's demonstrated passion for social justice. The recipient, who is successful academically and shows sensitivity to the marginalized, will participate in the Service & Justice Project at St. Thomas More College next academic year.

Guardian Legacy Scholarship

Student must be working at their potential and have achieved personal growth. Student must possess and exhibit the qualities of a good school citizen and those who would not normally receive public notice in the school. It is designed for students who are not on the honour roll but who plan to move on to professional and/or personal growth programs. This award is donated by an anonymous donor and the STJ Grad Committee.

### Lynn Quinn Scholarship

Involvement in and enjoyment of high school and/or community sports programs, as well as school and/or community fine arts programs. Demonstration of leadership ability in curricular or extra-curricular programs. Intended for first year full-time students attending a recognized post-secondary learning institution.

### Spirit of St. Joseph Award

This award is presented to a student who has made a significant contribution to the life of our school through his or her day-to-day actions behind the scenes. The Servant Leadership demonstrated by this student is often not in the public eye, yet he or she goes about doing good work, receiving little fanfare. The Spirit of St. Joseph award allows us to acknowledge this student for his or her efforts.

### Saskatchewan Youth Apprenticeship Award

Saskatchewan Youth Apprenticeship (SYA) Industry Scholarships are awarded to selected, eligible high school graduates throughout the province who have completed the SYA program and will be pursuing a career in the skilled trades.

### Grade 12 Leadership

The Grade 12 Leadership Award recognizes a student's overall contribution in all areas of school life. Candidates are nominated and selected by St. Joseph staff.

Recipients must:

- have demonstrated a commitment to Christian values
- have shown a commitment to academic excellence
- be a positive role model in and out of the classroom
- have supported the social and/or athletic programs
- have demonstrated leadership initiatives in the school
- be perceived by peers as a positive role model

### Kamamak

The 2017 After Grad Committee donated funds which allowed us to create The Kamamak Award. Kamamak is the Cree word for butterfly. As we all know, prior to becoming a Kamamak, challenge and often struggle must be overcome. This award will be given each year to students in each grade, who have persevered and has overcome hardships in and or out of school. This award is voted on by the entire St. Joseph Staff.

### Female and Male Athlete of the Year

Presented annually to one female athlete and one male Athlete in each grade that makes an outstanding contribution to athletics by displaying:

- a) Christian leadership and Sportsmanship
- b) A commitment to excellence in high school athletics, with preference given to an athlete that participates in a broad range of activities and is a positive role model for his/her team and our school. Exemplifying what sport is all about.

### Guardian Athletic Dedication Award

Presented annually to athletes that make an outstanding contribution to athletics by displaying a commitment to excellence in high school athletics, with preference given to an athlete that participates in a broad range of activities and is a positive role model for his/her team and our school. He/she exemplifies what sport is all about by displaying Christian leadership and Sportsmanship.

### The Greater Saskatoon Catholic School Board Scholarship

This scholarship is given to the student with the highest average in grade twelve.

### The Governor General Medal

Awarded to the student who achieves the highest average of all grade 11 and grade 12 final marks listed on the student's official Ministry of Education transcript.
