FLEX Period – What exactly is it?

- 2 periods a week that students use for individualized support.
- ☐ The purpose of the FLEX time is to provide students with time and flexibility to address competencies and content; time to meet with teachers for support, guidance, or inspiration regarding specific curriculum, or other passions and interests; the opportunity to collaborate with other students, teachers, or community members; and time to explore, work on, or complete assignments and projects

FLEX Period

- Provides students with choice, voice, and flexibility with their learning.
- Opportunities to complete assignments, study, collaborate with peers, or engage in a personal area of interest.
- Make up missed exams
- Promote well-being for the entire school population.
- □ Provides flexible learning environments for all, acknowledging that learning can take place in a variety of places and in a variety of ways.

FLEX Period

- Supports student time management and organization, by providing an opportunity for students to practice these skills with the guidance of teachers.
- □ Teachers/Administrators may require students to attend a specific FLEX period time to complete assignments, assessments, and receive extra help.
- Provides time and space for teacher-enriched learning opportunities.


