ii. School-wide Student Retreat – Face to Face

- We would like to have Face to Face Ministries to facilitate our student retreat for the 2025-2026 school year. The dates have not been confirmed.

- The total cost of the Face to Face Retreat last year was \$2101.50. The cost of the priest honorariums is \$225 (\$75x 3 priests). We received \$1200 from the Catholic Schools Foundation for our retreat. We expect to receive a similar amount this year.
- Request \$1126 to cover the remaining cost of the retreat.
