*May 11<sup>th</sup> is Catholic Education Week, and amongst other activities, we will host a schoolwide Liturgy to celebrate the fact that we have Catholic education here in Saskatchewan.*

*May 14<sup>th</sup> is our 5<sup>th</sup> annual track meet that we are hosting with three other schools at Gordie Howe Park. This is for Gr 4 and up.*

*And on Friday, May 15<sup>th</sup>, the staff will be having their annual Staff Retreat, so there*

*will be no school for students. And that is just the first two weeks of May!*

👉 **Successful fundraising efforts:** The Easter Basket Raffle was a great success, raising over \$2,200 which exceeded expectations. Half of the profits will be equally split between St. Michael's School

(to help with a year-end field trip) and the Saskatoon Food Bank & Learning Centre based on a vote by CSCC.

**🎓 Grade 8 updates:** Fundraising continues (bottle drive, upcoming lunch and possible ice cream sale), but the Camp Kadash trip was cancelled due to staffing concerns. Students will instead plan alternative year-end activities, including a day at Shekinah Retreat Centre.

**🚚 Funding decisions & finances:** The CSCC has surpassed its fundraising goal. A motion was approved to allocate **\$400/classroom** to support field trips with the money raised through the Healthy Hunger lunches.

**🏠 School programs & highlights:** The Artist-in-Residence program is a major success, alongside upcoming cultural and wellness initiatives (smudging ceremony, Mental Health Week, Treaty 6 learning). A new hockey academy partnership is also launching next year.

**📅 Upcoming events & initiatives:** Key dates include the school swim day and continued planning for student activities and field trips.

The next CSCC meeting is scheduled for **May 21, 2026 at 6:30 p.m.** in the St. Luke school library.
