Grade 9 Elective Course Descriptions

Construction & Carpentry 90 (\$70 Fee)

This course introduces students to the exciting world of carpentry through hands-on learning and project-based work. Students develop practical skills by safely using power tools to design and build their own projects. A strong emphasis is placed on tool safety, helping students gain confidence and responsibility in the workshop.

Throughout the course, students explore a variety of carpentry skills and techniques, from measuring and planning to cutting, assembling, and finishing. This class is ideal for students who enjoy working with their hands, creating tangible results, and learning skills that can be used in everyday life or future trades pathways.

Digital Arts 90 (\$20 Fee)

We live in a growing digital world where advances in technology happen in the blink of an eye. This course is an introduction to communications media, graphic art, and photography. Students will learn photo manipulation skills, video, and audio editing, as well as composition and layout techniques to make their media projects stand out in this fast-paced industry. This is a hands-on, project-based course that includes exciting assignments in digital media. Some potential projects that students could experiment with are poster making, commercials, podcasting, advertisements, photo stories, website design, and much more. Students will develop a sense of digital literacy and creativity as well as explore careers in the field.

Foods & Clothing 90 (\$50 Fee)

Foods & Clothing 90 is a hands-on course that introduces students to essential life skills they'll use every day. In a fun and welcoming learning environment, students learn kitchen safety and sanitation, practical food preparation techniques, and smart, healthy eating habits. The course features plenty of baking and cooking labs where students get to plan, prepare, and enjoy a variety of foods.

Students also explore the basics of clothing and textile skills by learning how to safely use sewing equipment and practice both hand and machine sewing. Through creative projects, students will gain confidence while designing and constructing their own creative sewing projects. This course is perfect for students who enjoy learning by doing and want to build practical skills for life.

French 90
