Holy Spirit Parish News

In the Diocese of Saskatoon, grade 6 is the common time for Baptized children to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. In July 2020, the Bishop moved the age of Confirmation from grade 2 to grade 6. At Holy Spirit Parish we prepare our students for the Sacrament of Confirmation starting in February with the celebration of Confirmation happening during the Easter Season. If your child is not Baptized, you need not register for the Sacraments. If you would like your child to get Baptized or if they need to receive their First Reconciliation and First Communion, contact the parish office at 306-374-1425.
