3.0 General Governance Commitment Policy

Policy

On behalf of the electors of Saskatoon and area, Biggar, Humboldt, Viscount, Martensville and Warman, the Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools' Board of Education will govern with a strategic perspective continually improving its processes and capability to express virtues and vision.

1. The Board of Education will define its Board Priorities and Goals, and Educational Commitments to the achievement of the Mission of the school division. It will delegate performance on these matters to the director of education. It will define in Executive Limitations Policies those conditions it considers unacceptable.
2. In fulfilling its function, the Board of Education will emphasize policy, strategy and corporate decision making.
3. The Board of Education will be committed to systematic contact with its electors in order to discern the common good.
4. Conduct of Board of Education members will be consistent with gospel virtues and their policy-making responsibility.
5. The Board of Education will operate in all matters according to procedures which it has determined in accordance with its own policies and provincial legislation.
