

News from the Office

Water Bottles

Please remember to send water bottles with your child(ren). Cups at the office are for emergency only, not a daily occurrence. Thanks for your help with this.

Safety At Our Crosswalks

This is just a reminder to be safe when crossing our streets at the crosswalks. Please don't ever assume that a car will stop. Make sure that cars come to a complete stop before crossing the streets. We do not want any of our students hurt. Please talk this over with your child(ren) and remind them of this very important safety concern.

Parking Out Front

As the weather is getting colder, parking can and will be a problem out front. Please remember to not get out of your vehicle, as these are drop off and pick up spots only. Traffic jams are very common around 3:30 as well – to help avoid this – you could tell your kids to meet you at the Willowgrove square area or arrive 10 -15 minutes later to help avoid the line ups. There is no great solution to this parking issue, so please try your best to help us with it. Also, **do not park in the Daycare spots** – these are courtesy spots meant for parents with young children and babies who are taking their kids to and from the daycare.

School Arrival

Students should not be at school prior to 8:45 in the morning. <u>Exterior doors will remain locked until 8:45AM</u>. If students need to arrive early, we have a Before and After School Program available through Preston Early Learning. In addition, students are asked to proceed directly into the school when they arrive since <u>there is no supervision on the playground prior to 9AM</u>.

If your child/children arrive late, the door they normally enter in will be locked, so please have them enter through the front door and *let* the office know they have arrived.

Attendance and Edsby

Please remember to use Edsby to report all absences and planned absences. If you still have not received an invitation to Edsby, please let the school know. Once you have accepted, you will also see all of our newsletters, calendar of upcoming events and any other important information. We will slowly be phasing out Safe Arrival, so please make sure you have an account through Edsby. If you need any assistance, please contact the school office at 306-659-7850 and we can help you.

Safe Arrival Ending after Easter Break

Starting after the Easter Break, we will no longer be using Safe Arrival to submit attendance for students. If you need to enter an absence for your child(ren), you will have to use Edsby or call the office at 306-659-7850. We will still be using School Messenger to send out the phone calls, but you will not be able to respond to them like you did with Safe Arrival. If you do receive a phone call stating that your child is absent, please respond by entering an absence in Edsby or calling the school. Thanks for your help with this.

Kindergarten Registration

We are always accepting registrations for our upcoming school year for kindergarten. Children who will be 5 years old by January 31, 2023 are eligible to start school next fall. Royal City Soccer Club




