

"Calculating Your Admission Average"

If you are currently enrolled in high school, or if you have already graduated but have undertaken little or no other post-secondary education*, we will calculate your admission average following this five-mark formula: *fewer than 18 credits

- One English
- One Math
- Three other approved subjects:
 - o Maximum of two natural sciences
 - o Maximum of **two** social sciences or humanities
 - Maximum of one fine or performing art

For applicants who have completed high school, only marks for senior-level (Grade 12) subjects will be used.

If you are currently enrolled in high school, marks for Grade 11-level subjects may be used as predictors for performance in Grade 12-level subjects if an appropriate Grade 12-level subject has not already been completed.
