Look what E-Tahkanawasot has to offer your child!

If you are attending high school or a high school equivalency program, are under 22 years of age, and your child(ren) is under the age of five, you are eligible to attend. We may also be able to offer some community spaces.

- School provides breakfast and lunch every day.
- Outside play is part of our program.
- We will arrange for your child to get immunizations. A nurse from Public Health comes to the School.
- A Speech Pathologist comes to the Centre if you or the Early Childhood Educator have any concern with your child's speech development.
- We are teaching children to care for the environment by using recycled materials for art projects.
- A Dental Educator is also available to give us information as to how help children to have healthy teeth.

Most importantly, if you are having difficulty handling school, parenting or you just need someone to talk to, we are here to help.

- Our Administrator can help you with child care concerns.
- The Centre can refer you to the School Counsellor who can help you.



E-Tahkanawasot has great child care for your children!

- E-Tahkanawasot is a facility licensed by the Ministry of Education. We are licensed for 33 children: 12 infants, 10 toddlers, 6 preschoolers and 5 flexible spaces.
- We provide cultural programming for the children and parents at the Centre.
- We have regular routines for children, including breakfast, lunch, snacks, naptime (optional), programmed activities and outdoor play such as walks, trike riding and the use of a playground.
- Our Early Childhood Educators have formal training in Early Childhood Development and use respectful child rearing practices. Physical discipline, yelling and labelling children are unacceptable. With your permission, the Educators use the ASQ-3 Questionnaire to monitor your child's development.
- We have bright, cheery rooms for children to play in, with lots of stimulating toys and equipment. All children's areas are child safe.
