EAB Staff Services: Off-Street Parking at Schools

Statement of Policy

Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools will strive to provide electrified off-street parking for staff at its school sites.

Rationale

Off-street parking supports a safe and convenient environment for employees who use their personal vehicles to drive to and from work and/or are required from time to time to use their personal vehicles in the discharge of their duties.

Authority

The Education Act, Section 85 (1) (w)

Guidelines

- 1. Off-street parking will be provided at new schools as part of the initial construction and at existing schools as soon as finances permit.
- 2. Where site limitations do not allow for off-street parking, administration will seek alternate arrangements.
- 3. There will be a charge, established annually, for staff who choose to use the electrical service.
- 4. The school division is not liable for damage to an employees' vehicle unless the damage was caused by the operations of the school division or its subcontractors. Policy FAA refers to the administration of vehicle damage caused by a student.

Procedures

The Chief Financial Officer will set the annual charge for the use of the electrical service.
