POLICY TITLE AND CODE

PROFESSIONAL STAFF - DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES - TEACHERS GDC

STATEMENT OF POLICY

Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools will define the conditions of employment for its teachers.

RATIONALE

It is central to the mission of Catholic education that the teachers with Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools emulate the essential elements of a Catholic Christian identity.

AUTHORITY

> The Education Act, Section 231

GUIDELINES

- 1. Teachers are to model Catholic Christian gospel values.
- 2. The lifestyle of a teacher is to be consistent with the official teachings of the Church.
- 3. Teachers are to be a participating member of a Catholic parish community.
- 4. Teachers are to strive for instructional excellence to maximize student achievement.
- 5. Teachers shall fulfill the general duties as defined in Section 231 of *The Education Act*.
- 6. Teachers are to abide by the Code of Ethics of the Saskatchewan Teachers' Federation.
- 7. Teachers are to attend professional development and inservices as mandated by Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools.
