

SCHOOL DAY AND YEAR – NUMBER OF DAYS OF INSTRUCTIONAL TIME

POLICY

LEGAL REF: EA 163 to 168

1. In any academic year, the minimum number of days devoted to in-school instruction shall not be less than 180. It is expected that students will spend this time in their classrooms or in activities directly related to the program of studies which may take them out of their classrooms for short periods of time such as visits to a library, art gallery, or musical performances.

2. In any academic year, the maximum number of days devoted to extended out-of-school pupil activities and professional staff development programs shall not exceed 20. It is expected that these would include such activities as outdoor education activities, field meets, teacher institutes, and conventions.
