Statement of Policy

Procedures/Guidelines

- 1. The board is committed to providing:
 - a) Consultative Services
 - b) Assessment Services
 - c) Support Services
 - d) Alternative Education Programs to support the individual learning needs of students
- The principal, in consultation with school and the student services team shall recommend and document the need for specialized program and/or intensive support.
- 3. The placement into a specialized program and/or the need for intensive support/services, shall be done in consultations with parents/guardians and students.
