

SCHOOL ADMISSIONS – CHILDREN WHO ARE WARDS OF THE GOVERNMENT

POLICY

LEGAL REF: EA 142, 173

1. Children who are wards of the government and as such are placed in a foster home, group home, or institution as defined by the Child Welfare Act are, for purposes of the School Act, defined to be children of bona fide residents of the division.
2. Such children will be permitted to register providing:
 - a) They meet the age and academic requirements for admission.
 - b) The guardians of non-Catholic children complete the necessary documentation as outlined in Policy IBD.
