

Statement of Policy

Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools provides the children and parents of the school division learning opportunities within the context of the board's vision, mission and beliefs.

Rationale

All persons, according to The Education Act, 1995, who have attained the age of six (6) years, but not yet attained the age of twenty-two (22) years, have the right to attend a school in a school division and a right to secure instruction appropriate to their age and level of educational achievement.

Authority

- *The Education Act (1995), Section 85(f)*

Guidelines

1. Children will be admitted to year one provided they are six (6) years of age on or before January 31 of the school year in which they wish to register.
2. In certain cases, children not meeting the age requirement may also be admitted to year one:
 - a) Children Who have Attended Kindergarten

Children who have attended kindergarten in a provincial government recognized school jurisdiction will be admitted to year one upon receipt of a satisfactory attendance and progress report.
 - b) Children Who have Not Attended Kindergarten

Children who will reach their sixth birthday between February 1 and June 30, inclusive, of a school year will be admitted to year one if their readiness for school at the commencement of a new school year has been established by the school division.
3. Children seeking placement in year one must present appropriate proof of age at the time of registration.
