

Student Attendance - Home-Based Education

Statement of Policy

ICD

Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools acknowledges the legal right of parents/guardians to direct the education of their children within their home.

Rationale

Parents/guardians are the primary educators of their children; therefore, parents/guardians may choose to direct the education of their children through a registered home-based education program.

Authority

The Education Act, 1995 Sections 2,4(p)(q)(r),85(n),86(n), 117(2),157(1)(c), 370(j)(k)(l)(m)(n)

Definitions

Home-Based Education: An educational programming option that is started at the initiative of and under the direction of the parent or guardian of the child. The child is receiving instruction at and from the home of the child.

Guiding Principles

- 1. Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools will administer home-based education as per the Saskatchewan Home-Based Education: Policy and Procedures Manual.
- 2. The home-based education plan shall include a minimum of three learning goals each year specific to Catholic education.

Process

1. Each home-based educator will receive a copy of the Home-Based Education Information when registering with Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools.
