ADVERTISING IN SCHOOLS – ADVERTISING AND SOLICITING

POLICY LEGAL REF: EA 87, 368

1. Unless authorized by the Director, no person shall be admitted to the school for the purposes of:

- a) Promoting the sale of insurance, stocks, bonds, supplies, or other articles or materials.
- b) Distributing literature of a political nature.
- 2. A demonstration of teaching aides by a representative of a commercial firm will be permitted if the person has been invited by the principal.
- 3. The following activities are all prohibited unless express permission has been given by the Director:
 - a) The taking up of collections or the selling of subscriptions not related directly to the school program.
 - b) The distribution of advertising materials.
 - c) Questionnaires or surveys
