Halloween Activities

Halloween is fast approaching. The word hallow is another word for a saint, a holy person. Therefore, the night before All Saints' Day is called All Hallows Eve, or Halloween. For Halloween, some of the rules of life change a bit. Instead of ordinary clothes, we wear costumes. We can play the part of saints or heroes or people with special talents. We can play funny tricks and ask neighbors for treats. We also change the rules of fear. We laugh at things that scare us - spooks, skeletons and slimy things that go "boo!" They cannot separate us from Jesus and the joy of this resurrection.

On Friday, October 29th, students will be allowed to wear costumes at school for the **entire day**. The expectation is that students will be able to complete their schoolwork in whatever they are wearing.

Points to consider about costumes on Halloween:

- Weapons of any kind will **NOT** be allowed.
- Costumes should be **simple.** Please keep accessories at home.
- Costumes should allow for students to move around and enable them to participate in learning for the entire day.

Some parts of Halloween costumes may have to be left at home or not be so extravagant to accommodate the above points. We also want to make sure that students have all parts of the costume for the weekend if they are planning to go trick-or-treating.

News from the Office:

<u>Picking up students early</u> If you are planning on picking up your child early from school, please put a note into your child's planner or backpack as well as on Edsby. Due to the large number of students in our building, we cannot always get to each and every message that needs to be sent. Teachers have the responsibility of running the classroom and cannot keep track of each individual pick up times. If you need your child to meet you outside at a certain time, please call the office 10-15 minutes prior to pick up and we can page them to come and meet you.

Parent Parking

Parents are welcome to park in the angled parking spots located in the parking inlet in front of the school. We ask that you park only in these stalls and not along the opposite side since this is posing safety issues. When parked in the angled stall, please remain in your vehicles since this is a quick drop off and pick up area. Also students are not to be dropped off or picked up from the staff parking lot as this causes safety concerns.



School Arrival

Students should not be at school prior to 8:45 in the morning. Exterior doors will remain locked until 8:45AM. If students need to arrive early, we have a Before and After School Program available through Preston Early Learning. In addition, students are asked to proceed directly into the school when they arrive since there is no supervision in the playground prior to 9AM.

If your child/children arrive, late, the door they normally enter in will be locked, so please have them enter through the front door and let the office know they have arrived.
