

Saskatchewan School Boards Association: Convention Voting Procedures

In accordance with the rules of the Saskatchewan School Boards Association for convention voting, the Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools' Board of Education trustees shall vote at Saskatchewan School Boards Association conventions as follows:

A. Voting Delegates

Each trustee member of the Board of Education who attends the annual convention shall be deemed to be a voting delegate.

B. Allocation of Votes

Votes shall be allocated in whole numbers.

1) Base Number

Votes in whole numbers will be allocated evenly among the voting delegates by dividing the number of votes by the number of declared delegates.

Votes

Declared Delegates ÷ Base number of votes per delegate

2) Unallocated Remainder

In the event that there is an unallocated vote(s) remaining after the number of base votes has been determined, this remainder will be allocated by a draw of a name(s) of a trustee(s) delegate(s) awarding one vote per name until the unallocated remainder has been assigned.

C. Authorized Trustee Delegate

The voting rules require that one trustee delegate be declared by the board as the authorized person to collect the board's package of ballot books at the beginning of Convention and to distribute the ballots (base number and unallocated remainder) to fellow trustee delegates in accordance with these rules as established by the board. One trustee delegate will be appointed by the Chairperson as the authorized person.

Casting of Ballots

A voting delegate must be present at the Saskatchewan School Boards Association Convention to cast any ballot. The voting delegate may cast no more ballots than those equal to the number of votes apportioned to that delegate by the authorized trustee delegate.
